

Questions for the Under-Treasurer

Funding for the Queensland Police Service

1. What are the various mechanisms by which the Queensland Police Service is funded?

Annual funding

2. In respect of the annual budget for the Queensland Police Service:
 - a. Is the Queensland Police Service required, as part of its annual funding request, to outline how the budget will be allocated to its various capabilities, and for what purposes?
 - b. If so, in the financial years since the Not Now, Not Ever report was released in 2016, what has the Queensland Police Service said, in its funding requests, about what resources were required to respond effectively to domestic and family violence?
 - c. Is there a mechanism by which the Queensland Police Service is required to report back to Treasury as to how it allocated its funding, and the outcomes of that allocation?

Other requests for funding by the Queensland Police Service

3. In respect of funding requests that have occurred other than as part of the annual budget:
 - a. How many requests for funding in relation to domestic and family violence projects has the Queensland Police Service made since 2016?
 - b. What projects did those funding requests relate to?
 - c. What assessments, undertaken by the Queensland Police Service, accompanied those requests?
 - d. What were the outcomes of the funding requests?
4. Was the Queensland Police Service required to report back to Treasury about how the funding was allocated, and the outcomes of the allocation?
5. Was there any process for the evaluation of the funded projects?
