ORDER TO PROHIBIT PUBLICATION OF EVIDENCE

I, HER HONOUR JUDGE DEBORAH RICHARDS, Commissioner appointed pursuant to Commissions of Inquiry Order (No.2) 2022 to inquire into certain matters pertaining to the Queensland Police Service responses to domestic and family violence, ORDER THAT:

1. Subject to further order of the Commissioner:

- a. The documents entitled RAIS Briefing Note, Complaint Summary, Green Sheet, Commissioners Operational Briefing, and Reminder – Use of Social Media, produced by QPS about Facebook posts [REDACTED] shall not be published or made publicly accessible beyond access by the legal representatives of QPS, QPUE and WLS; and
- b. The documents entitled OMCG DFV Assessment, and SIFC Assessment – what is the likely impact of COVID-19 on regional Qld Domestic and family violence occurrences, produced by the QPS shall not be published or made publicly accessible beyond access by the legal representatives of QPS, QPUE and WLS
