Background / Overview

- ❖ On 26/2/21 the Commissioner circulated an email regarding the stand-up of the Domestic, Family Violence and Vulnerable Persons Command.
- ❖ On 12/3/21 the Commissioner signed the Executive Direction to transfer function responsibility of the Vulnerable Persons Group from Road Policing and Regional Support Command to the Domestic, Family Violence and Vulnerable Persons Command.
- ❖ On 17/3/21 the RAC approved the establishment of the interim DFVVP Command Office in response to the Commissioner's email.
- ❖ On 30/4/21 the RAC approved the transition of the Vulnerable Persons Group incl. the State DFVVP Unit from RPRSC to the DFVVP Command.
- ❖ On 8/6/21 the RAC approved the PERM staffing model (8 staff member positions and 12 police positions) for the State DVVP Unit, DFVVP Command including the transition of 6 existing TEMP staff members positions from TEMP to PERM, 2 new PERM staff member positions, and 1 new TEMP police position.
- ❖ On 23/6/21 the RAC approved the PERM staffing model for QPS HRT Team, State DFVVP Unit, DFVVP Command including the transition of 20 existing TEMP staff member positions from TEMP to PERM.
- ❖ On 1/7/21 the AO3 position was converted from TEMP to PERM as part of the PSBA MOG to QPS.
- ❖ On 31/1/22 the WAS approved the reallocation of 14 positions (2 within DFVVP Command Office, 12 within the State DFVVP Unit) from within to formalise the PERM police staffing model for the DFVVP Command, transitioning 14 existing TEMP police positions from TEMP to PERM.
- ❖ On 6/5/22 the WAS approved the creation of 7 TEMP positions to support the development of the DFV training products to meet the QPS training commitments made in the Coroner's Court inquest proceedings.

The Domestic, Family Violence and Vulnerable Persons Command has not made any further representation for resources through or to the Workforce Allocation Sub-Committee (formerly the Resource Allocation Committee).
