**1.0 Executive Summary**

- On the 17 March 2021 the RAC approved the establishment of the interim Domestic, Family Violence and Vulnerable Persons Command (DFVVPC) Office, including the creation of 3 TEMP positions:
  - (4-959040) 1 x ASCOM
  - (4-959041) 1 x INSP Strategy and Performance Inspector
  - (4-959042) 1 x AO3 Executive Assistant
- An existing PERM INSP position has been identified for reallocation to the DFVVPC Office with agreement of the Substantive Occupant Leonie FORDYCE [REDACTED]
  - (1-924172) INSP Principal Strategy Officer, Planning and Performance (P&P)
- The current TEMP INSP position (4-959041) will be abolished on transition of the INSP position from P&P to DFVVPC.

The matter will be referred back to the RAP to advise the Director, Human Resources, Director, Finance Services, Assistant Commissioner DFVVPC and Executive Director P&P to advise on the determination and coordinate relevant actions or otherwise as required.
