<p>5.5 Establishment of the Domestic, Family Violence and Vulnerable Persons Command</p> <p>Assistant Commissioner Codd provided an update on the status of the establishment of the Domestic, Family Violence and Vulnerable Persons (DFV&VP) Command.</p> <p>The ELT noted:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • An overview of the purpose and scope of the Command including the two primary responsibilities of the Assistant Commissioner: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ assume responsibility for strategic capability with respect to domestic and family violence; and ○ take functional command of the existing centralised DFV&VP Units. • An in-depth overview of how each of the following initial priorities of the Command will be actioned and progressed: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Establish DFV&VP Command; ○ Scan and engage with strategic environment; ○ Process improvement program; and ○ Envision future state. • The Command is being established through existing resources and zero growth. <p>Commissioner Carroll highlighted the need to research best practice and ensure this is embedded in our organisation. The ELT discussed the need to consider the most appropriate model for the future state.</p> <p>Resolution The ELT noted the update, discussed the scope, purpose and priorities of the new DFV Command and endorsed the ongoing establishment of the Command.</p>
