I, Dr Brian Sullivan, make oath and state as follows:

- I am an academic, professional practitioner, trainer, supervisor, and educator in the domestic violence sector. I have worked on perpetrator programs here in Qld and in the USA. For my PhD (2000), I researched the effectiveness of court-mandated programs for male domestic violence offenders. Until recently, I was the Senior Lecturer, Head of Course for the Domestic and Family Violence Practice Program at Central Queensland University.
- 2. I am on the Board of Red Rose Foundation and a member of the Qld Police Service Domestic and Family Violence Advisory Committee. I was an invited Qld delegate for the National Summit on Women's Safety Forum Perpetrator Intervention and Working with Men.
- 3. I have recently created my own company Sicura, which offers Domestic violence Intervention Education and Training. My focus is on safe and accountable domestic violence interventions for perpetrators.
