I, Louise Baker, make oath and state as follows:

- 1. I am a Manager with Brisbane Youth Service.
- 2. BYS has supported vulnerable young people aged 12-25 years and their children who are experiencing or are at risk of homelessness in Brisbane for over 45 years.
- 3. The majority of young people supported by BYS have experienced family violence and nearly half have experienced relationship violence in the past, and many are currently navigating intimate relationships that involve violence. Domestic and Family Violence (DFV) is a key driver of homelessness and often leads young people to have interactions with the police and court system.
- 4. BYS has several programs specifically supporting young people who have experienced DFV. These include a young women's program, healthy relationships groups and for the past two years has had an embedded worker from the Brisbane Domestic Violence Service
