

## Summary of investigations conducted – by rank and location

Data period: 30/5/2021 to 30/5/2022

### Member involved

Sixty-four records were provided, noting some subject members appeared more than once.

Each record represents an allegation of DFV perpetration.

Nine records indicate the case officer location as Ethical Standards Command, including PPMs.

Five records indicate the allegations were investigated by an officer of the same work unit or at the same station/establishment.

On five occasions the case officer is identified as of the same substantive rank as the subject member. Case officers listed as “acting” were counted at their substantive rank.

On one occasion the case officer was of a lesser rank than the subject member. Case officers attached to Internal Investigations Group, Ethical Standards Command, were not included in this count.

### Failure of duty

From the data provided, 126 records were identified by name and location (“unknown member” records were excluded).

Each recorded had at least one allegation of failure of duty related to DFV.

Twenty-six records indicate the subject members were investigated by a case officer of the same work group or at the same station/establishment.

On 20 occasions the subject member and case officer were of the same substantive rank. Case officers listed as “acting” were counted at their substantive rank.

On three occasions the case officer was of a lesser rank than the subject member. Case officers attached to Ethical Standards Command were not included in this count.
